


Lift the TV out of the box using the handles on the plastic bag covering the TV. Support the TV evenly on both sides while laying it on a padded, flat surface that is larger than the TV.

Install the stand feet or a wall mount^{*} (not included) according to the image below. When the stand legs are properly connected, the legs will not shift or move.






Once you are ready to start the on-screen setup, insert two AAA batteries into your remote control.





Plug the TV power cord into a wall outlet.

If you have a sound bar, connect it to your TV's HDMI ARC/eARC port (HDMI 1) now.

HDMI 1 (eARC) When connected to select VIZIO sound bars using the dedicated HDMI ARC/eARC port, audio settings can be adjusted easily via an on-screen menu.
